






First, open the Macintosh HD from your desktop.






Next, Click on the Apple, then System Preferences.



Click on International, or on MacOS 10.6 and later, the icon will be called Language and Texts. In this window, select the Input Menu tab.




In the Input Menu window, scroll down until you find the RC Lakota Keyboard. Check the box next to RC Lakota. Also make sure to check the box next to "Show input menu in menu bar."



Close the International window, and find the flag at the top right of your screen. Click it, then choose RC Lakota.

To type special characters using the new keyboard, you press Shift+6 to create the ^ character. After this, the ^ will be underlined as shown on the right. The computer is now waiting for you to enter the next character. If you press 'h' you will get the guttural h found in the word Lakhota.



The Shift+6 combination can be used with all special characters found in Lakota. Shift+6 plus a gives a stressed á, Shift+6 plus n gives the ŋ. This also works for capital letters. Shift+6 plus A gives a stressed Á, Shift+6 plus G gives Ğ.
