Capital Expenditures: In FY08 Red Cloud spent \$678,213 on capital projects.

Direct Mail Expenses: Over 75 percent of all development expenses were directly attributable to printing, postage and fees for an extensive direct-mail operation. Dictated by our remote location on an impoverished Indian reservation, with no wealthy alumni or local corporations to turn to, this direct-mail operation is a necessary but expensive way of securing the funds needed to operate. Red Cloud continues to work to decrease its reliance on direct-mail solicitation by increasing revenues from major donors and foundations.

Overall Increase in Net Assets in FY07: Red Cloud's FY08 operating activities show a surplus of \$2,087,289, in addition to \$408,501 added to permanent endowment. However, negative total returns in a year of troubled market conditions largely offset this surplus. Net assets increased by only \$345,032, from \$32,715,659 in FY07 to \$33,060,691 in FY08.

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
