This little dog (Šúnka in Lakota/Dakota) is having fun playing with Dakota florals. Please add color!

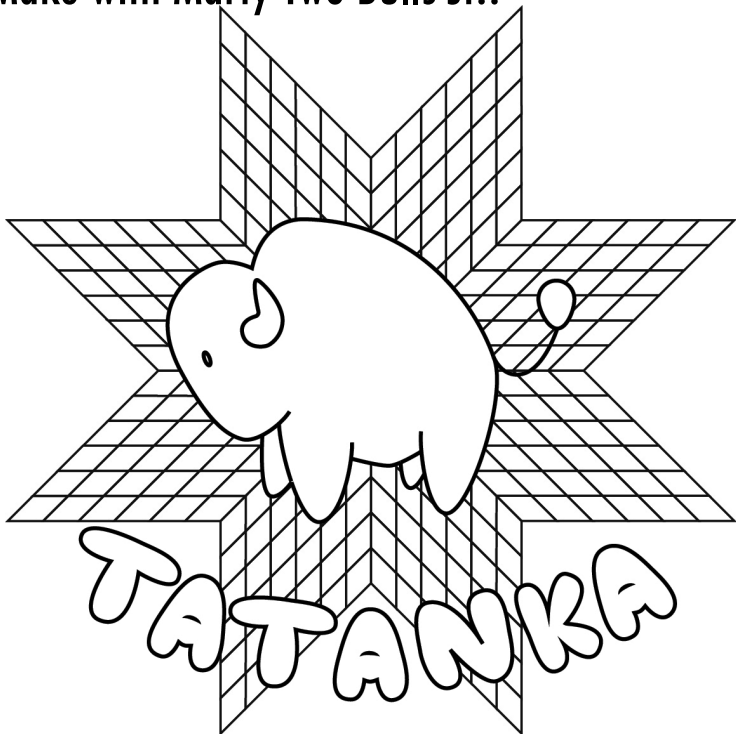

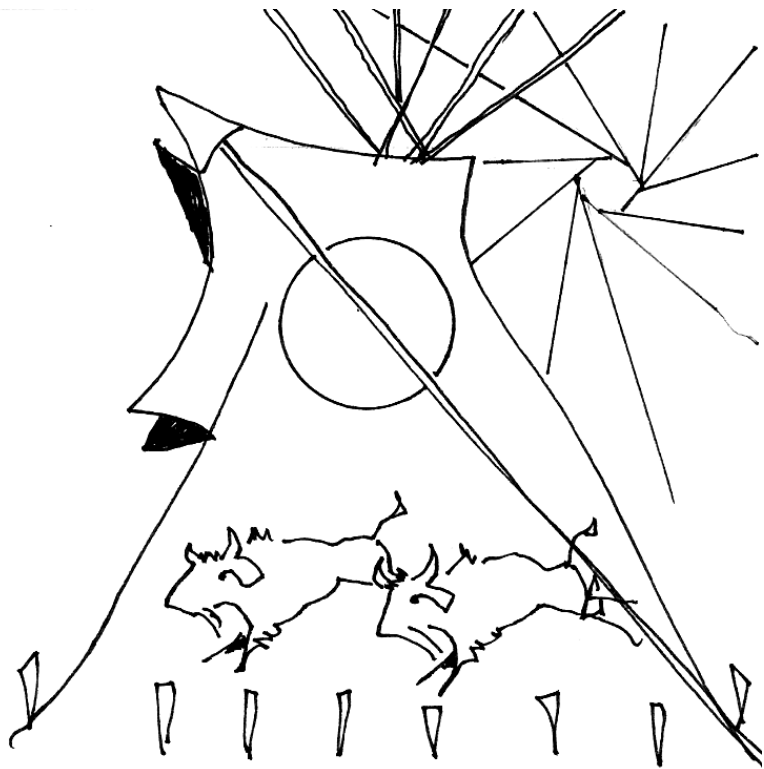

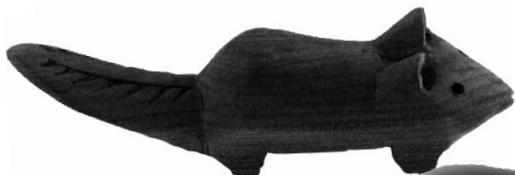

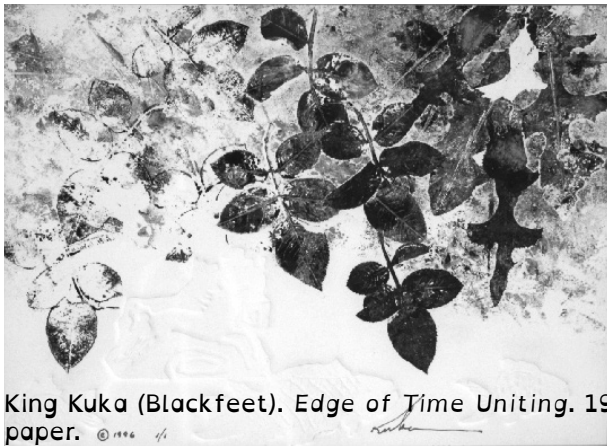


Ed Cobiness (Ojibwa). Moose, the Twig Eater. 1971.

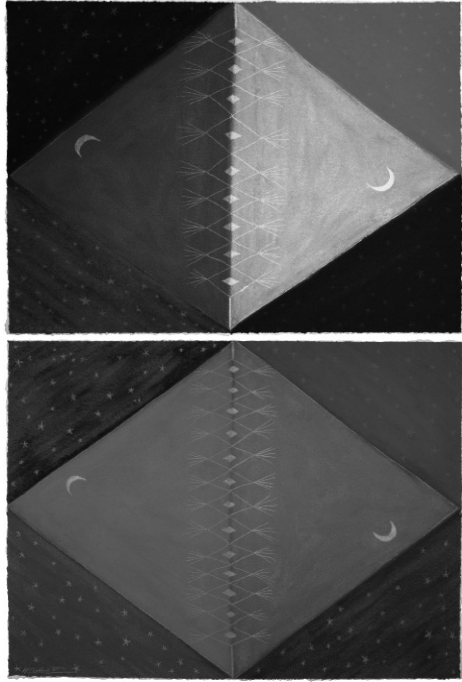
Borrow neat textures from nature!

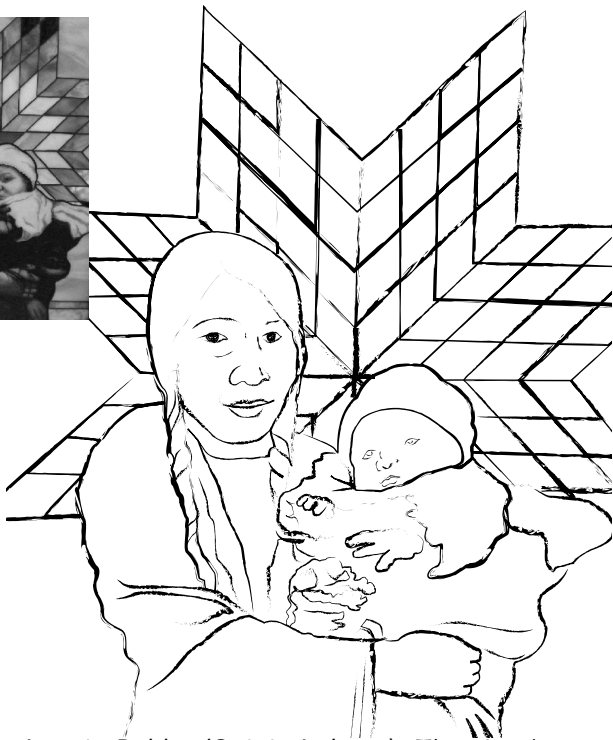

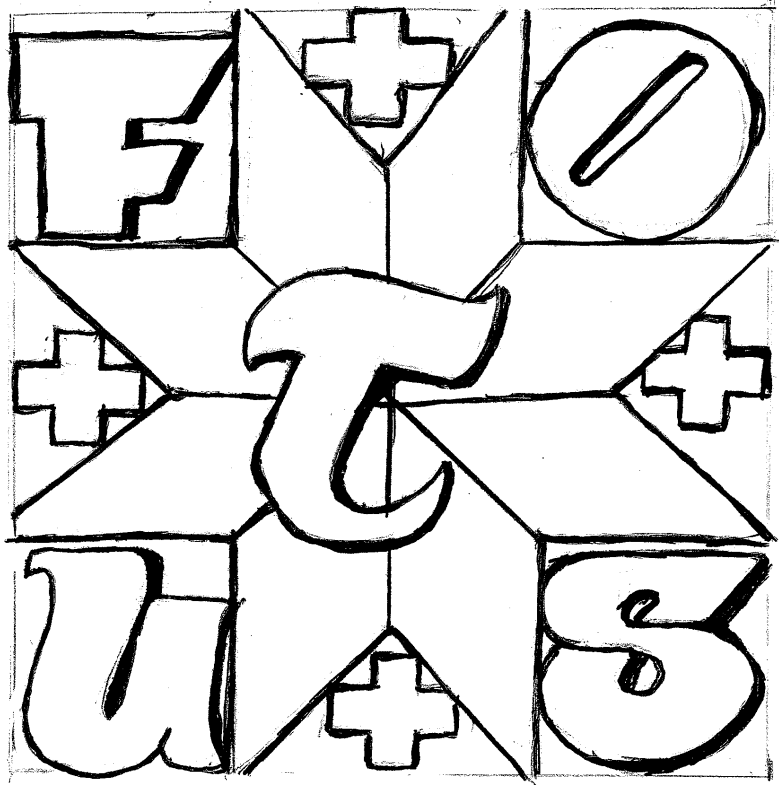
